

The Hayama Marina International Friendship Regatta

Organizing authority (OA): Hayama Marina Yacht Club (HMYC)

Venue: Hayama Marina, Japan

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Rules for handling the boats as attached to Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply.
- 1.4 Class Rule will not apply.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Five teams representing the embassies of Australia, France, New Zealand, Switzerland and U.S.A. in Japan will be invited. Only teams invited by the OA and a team representing HMYC will be eligible to enter this event.
- 3.2 Eligible teams may enter by completing the attached form by February 28th, 2014.
- 3.3 All crew including skipper shall be embassy staff member or his/her family in Japan, or a national of the embassy and living in Japan.
- 3.4 Each team shall include at least one crew (including skipper) of different gender while racing.

4 FEES

No Entry Fee is required. No Damage deposit is required.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Preliminary Team Leaders meeting is scheduled at 6:00pm on March 5th, 2014, at the headquarter office of Keikyu in Shinagawa, connected to the Sengakuji Station.
- 5.2 Registration: April 19th Saturday, from 9:00am to 9:30am.
- 5.3 Skippers briefing: April 19th Saturday 9:30am.
- 5.2 Racing day: April 19th Saturday.
- 5.3 Number of races: 3
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:30am.
- 5.5 Prize Giving and Regatta Party: April 19th Saturday, followed by the race.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the preliminary Team Leaders meeting on March 5th.

7 BOATS

7.1 Six YAMAHA 30S type boats will be provided by the OA. The races shall be sailed with these boats. Boats will be allocated to each team by draw at morning skippers briefing.

7.2 Following sails will be provided: Main, Jib and Spinnaker.

8 CREW

8.1 Recommended number of crew including the skipper while racing is 6 and maximum of 8 within the restriction of 8.2. Crew may be substituted with registered crew. Prior approval by OA is required for substitution. Request of substitution may be communicated orally. Each Team shall deliver the list of crew to register at the registration.

8.2 Total weight of the crew including skipper shall be 450 kg or less as per self-enumeration at registration.

8.3 In case a Team does not include crew with a Japanese boat licence, the OA will place a Japanese boat licence holder on the boat required by regulation. The licence holder placed by the OA shall be excluded for the purpose of 8.1 and 8.2. Each Team shall notify the OA of availability of boat licence holder in the entry form.

10 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the racing area.

11 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward and leeward course as described in Attachment B.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The races will be umpired. The rule changes relating to protest procedures will be described in the SI.

12.2 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

13 SCORING

13.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2 The boats' series score shall be the total of all races completed.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be announced at the leaders' meeting.

15 MEDIA, IMAGES and SOUND

15.1 If required by the OA, media personnel and equipment supplied by OA shall be carried on board while racing.

- 15.2 Competitors shall not interfere with the normal working of the OA supplied media equipment.
- 15.3 The OA have the right to use any images and sound recorded during the event free of any charge.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

The boats are insured with third-party liability insurance. However, the deductible of the insurance is applied. Teams may be required to pay up to this amount as maximum payable for the damage in an incident or the loss of equipment. Detail of the conditions will be informed at the leaders' meeting.

Yokohama-Yokosuka Highway, off at Zushi Exit for Zuyo Shindo to Hayama

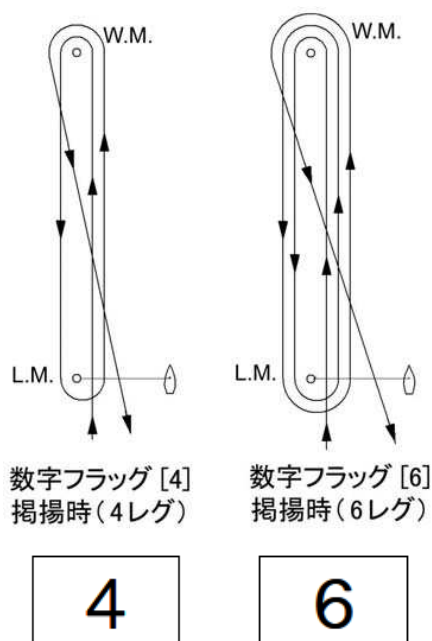
3. Prize Giving & Regatta Party
