Organizing authority (OA): Hayama Marina Yacht Club (HMYC)

Venue: Hayama Marina, Japan

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Rules for handling the boats as attached to Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply.
- 1.4 Class Rule will not apply.
- 1.5 “Experimental SI Appendix Q Umpired Fleet Racing Rules” will apply, as approved by Japan Sailing Federation under RRS 86.3. This appendix will appear in full in the SI.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Only teams invited by the OA and a team representing HMYC will be eligible to enter this event.
- 3.2 Eligible teams may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to Yoshihiko Higuchi at guchi1277@yahoo.co.jp , by 28 February, 2015.
- 3.3 At least 4 of the crew (including the skipper) must be embassy staff members or his/her family, someone affiliated with the embassy, or a national of the embassy. The embassy staff member or the affiliated person does not need to be the same nationality as the embassy he/she sails with.
- 3.4 Each team shall include at least one crew (including the skipper) of a different gender while racing.

4 FEES

No Entry Fee is required. No Damage deposit is required.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Preliminary Team Leaders meeting is scheduled on 16 February, 2015, 18:00pm, at the Head office of Keikyu Corporation.
- 5.2 Registration: 18 April, Saturday, from 9:00 to 9:30.
- 5.3 Skippers briefing: 18 April, Saturday 9:30.
- 5.2 Racing day: 18 April, Saturday.
- 5.3 Number of races: 3
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:30.
- 5.5 Awards Ceremony: 18 April, Saturday, 16:00

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be released by the end of March.

7 BOATS

- 7.1 Six YAMAHA 30S type boats will be provided by the OA. The races shall be sailed with these boats. Boats will be allocated to each team by the luck of the draw at the morning skippers briefing.
- 7.2 The Following sails will be provided: Main, Jib and Spinnaker.

8 CREW

- 8.1 Recommended number of crew including the skipper is 6 and a maximum of 8 within the restriction of 8.2. Crew may be substituted with registered crew. Prior approval by OA is required for substitution. Request for substitution may be communicated orally. Each Team shall deliver the list of crew at registration.
- 8.2 Total weight of the crew including skipper shall be 450 kg or less as per self-enumeration at registration.
- 8.3 Teams will be required to carry a person allocated by the OA. The person selected by the OA shall be excluded for the purpose of 8.1 and 8.2
- 8.4 A Host-team will be assigned to each Team by the OA. The person allocated to each Team according to NOR 8.3, will be a member of the Host-team. The Host-team will provide a support boat. Substitute crew shall stand by on that boat, unless otherwise arranged by the OA.

9 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbor and the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed are described in Attachment A.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

The races will be umpired, as detailed in the SI, Appendix Q.

13 SCORING

- 13.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.2 The boats' series score shall be the total of all races completed.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to each team.

15 MEDIA, IMAGES and SOUND

15.1 If required by the OA, media personnel and equipment supplied by the OA shall be carried on board while racing.

15.2 Competitors shall not interfere with the normal working of the OA supplied media equipment.

15.3 The OA have the right to use any images and sound recorded during the event free of charge.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

The boats are insured with third-party liability insurance with a cover of JPY 10 million and for the hull JPY 3 million per incident. However, the deductible of the insurance for the hull is JPY 300,000. Teams may be required to pay up to this amount as maximum payment for damage in an incident or the loss of equipment.

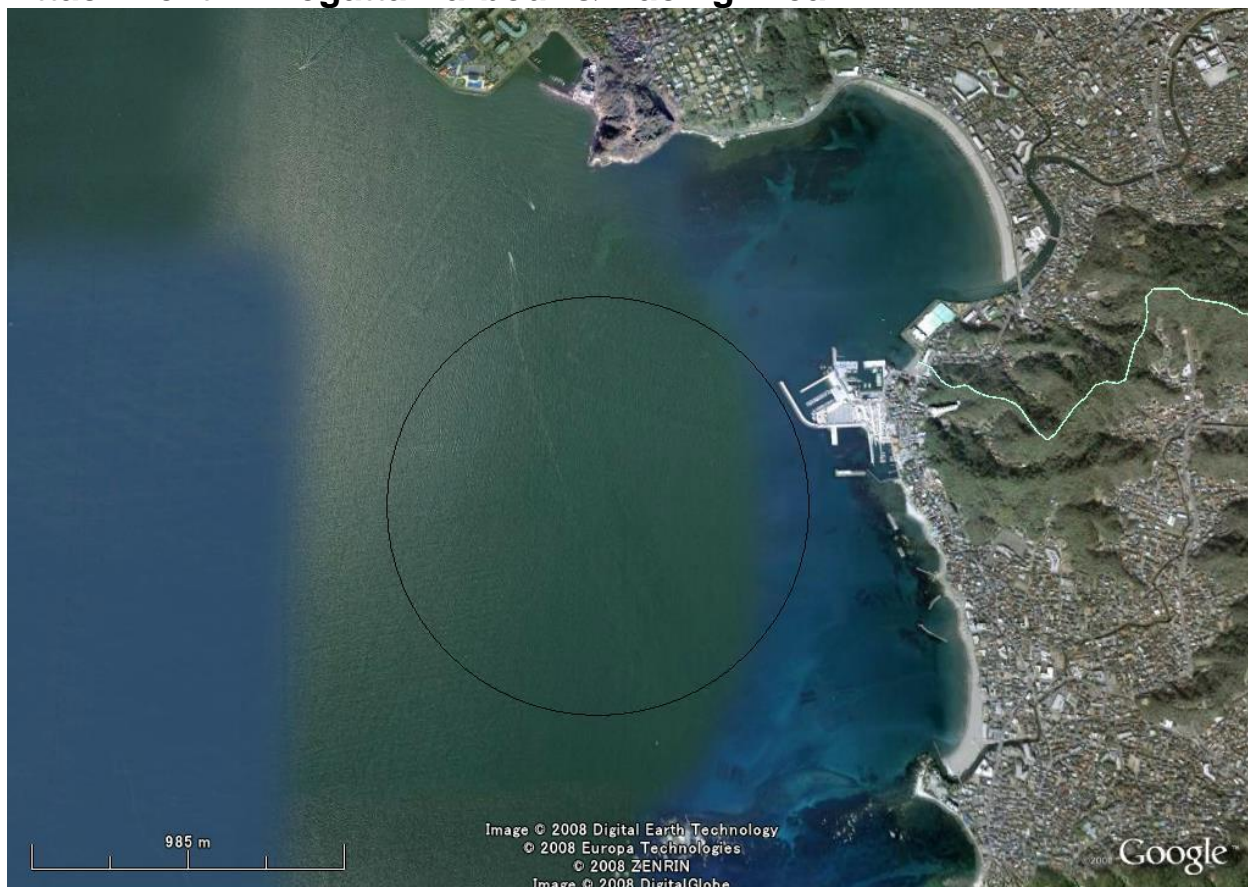

Attachment B: Race Boat



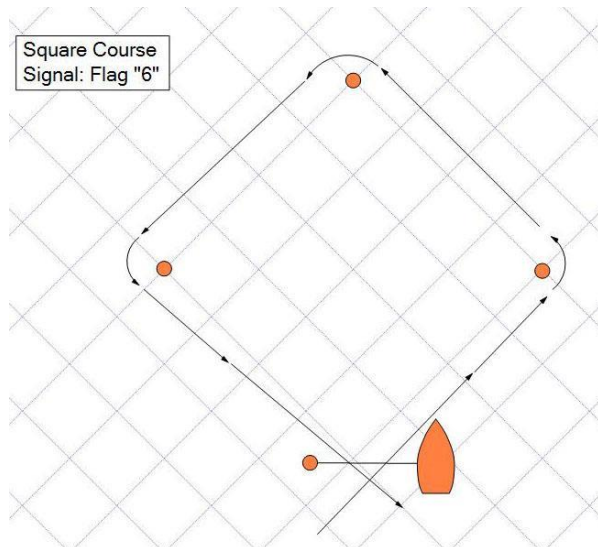
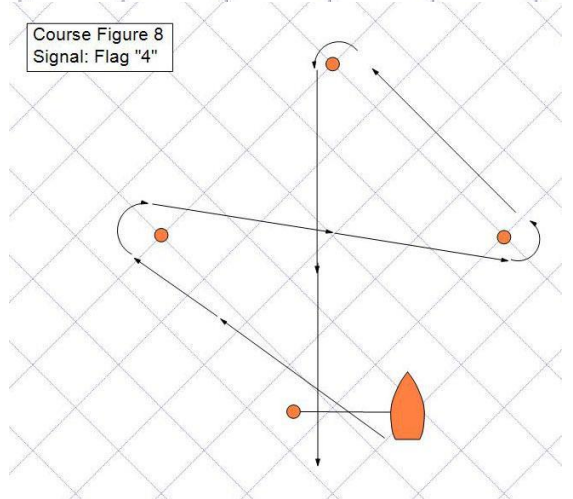
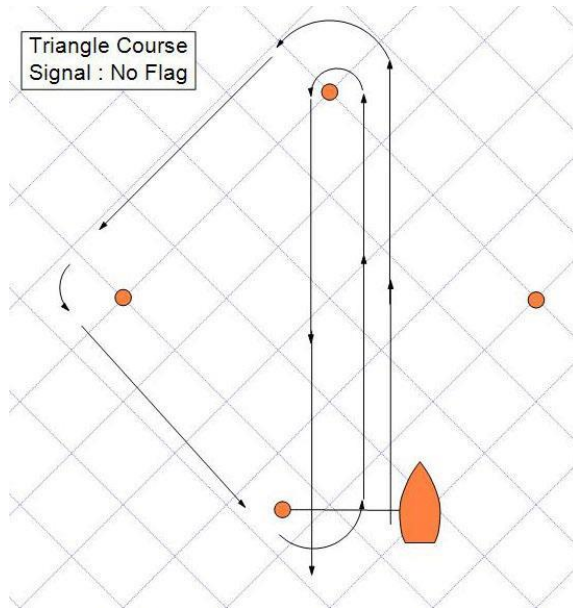
